The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

BASS STRAIT – OFFSHORE WESTERN PORT BAY
(PHILLIP ISLAND)
WAVE GAUGE BUOY

Date: 23 June 2014

Details: A temporary wave gauge buoy has been established offshore of Western Port Bay (Phillip Island) to assist in the collection of oceanographic data on behalf of the Port of Hastings Development Authority.

The wave gauge buoy will be deployed for a period of no longer than 10 weeks

The wave gauge buoy has the characteristics of a special mark buoy fitted with top mark and radar reflector, and is lit with the characteristics-
Flashing - Yellow 4 seconds. (FI Y 4s 3M).

The buoy will be marked with an identifier- WPO-01.

The buoy has been established in the approximate position:
Lat. -38° 35.687' Long. 145° 17.989'
WGS84.

Masters of vessel are requested to keep clear of, and not operate within 300 metres of the buoy.
