Marine Geotechnical Surveys in Western Port

Effective; 13th December 2013

Details; The Port of Hastings Development Authority has engaged contractors to carry out marine geotechnical surveys within Western Port using the jack-up barges listed below.

Crew transfer vessels and barge towing vessels will operate around the barges for various operational needs.

Survey work will be carried out between the 13th of December 2013 and the 30th of June 2014

Works will include borehole sampling and cone penetration testing from jack-up barges.

A 100m exclusion zone is in place around the jack-up barges. Mariners are directed to observe this exclusion zone and keep clear of survey vessels and equipment at all times.
